Scholarship Description: The United Maine Craftsmen, Inc. Arts Scholarships are for students with majors in the visual arts including, but not limited to, architecture, ceramics, drawing, fashion, graphic design, illustration, interior design, painting, photography, sketching, video production and other decorative arts.

Eligibility:

- Child or grandchild of an active United Maine Craftsmen member
- Currently / planning to be enrolled in the upcoming academic year as a full-time undergraduate student
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Be pursuing a major and career in a visual art
- Exhibit leadership and community service

Submission Requirements:

- Essay (750 - 1,000 words): write a cohesive essay on one of the following two topics:
 - 1) Hypothetically, what Maine artist would you choose to be your mentor and why; *or*
 - 2) In your opinion, what Maine artist has had the most influence on Maine's art community and why.
- Resume (three (3) pages maximum) detailing academics, extracurricular activities, honors, employment, community service, and special skills

Other:

Required documents must be submitted and postmarked by May 15th to United Maine Craftsmen, Inc., 16 Old Winthrop Road, Manchester, ME 04351. Incomplete applications will be returned. The decisions made by the United Maine Craftsmen Scholarship Committee are final and no appeals will be accepted. If applicant is declined, they are encouraged to reapply in a subsequent year.
